About the property

Daisy Cottage is an immaculately presented recently built two bedroom end of terrace home. Situated on a substantial plot with a generous rear garden the property backs on to open fields. The ground floor accommodation offers a light and airy open plan living / dining room, an individually designed kitchen with fitted bosch appliances, the downstairs is completed with a cloakroom.

To the first floor the master bedroom, which overlooks open fields to the rear, has a built in wardrobe and an ensuite shower room with heated towel rail. The second double bedroom also benefits from a built in wardrobe. The family bathroom is fitted with a white suite and heated towel rail.

To the outside there are two allocated parking spaces and a rear garden with direct side access. N.B The property is fully alarmed and has BT Cat 5 internet and infrastructure for E.V charge point.

Amenities

Situated just 5 miles from the ancient Roman town of Cirencester in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, Poulton is a small village with a pretty 19th century church, Village Hall and a popular gastro-pub, The Falcon Inn.

Backing on to open fields, Wheeler's Rise is perfectly placed for a huge variety of outdoor activities including country walks, cycling and horse riding. South Cerney Golf Club is less than 5 miles away and the popular Cotswold Water Park - just 6 miles - boasts 180 lakes over 40 square miles and offers something for everyone, no matter what age or ability, from wildlfie spotting to water-skiing.

Whilst enjoying a rural location, Poulton is wellplaced for easy access to Cirencester - 'The capital of the Cotswolds' with its excellent variety of shops, bars and restaurants, whilst

Swindon - just 17 miles away, also provides high speed rail access to London and Bristol.

There are a number of schools in the area, with a good choice of primary schools in the neighbouring villages and secondary schools in both Cirencester or nearby Fairford.

Directions

Leave Cirencester on the London Road and take the A417 towards Poulton. Passing the Falcon Pub on your left continue you through the village. Take a left towards Quenington/Bibury on to the B4425, Bell Lane. Wheeler's Rise is on the right hand side after 500 meters.

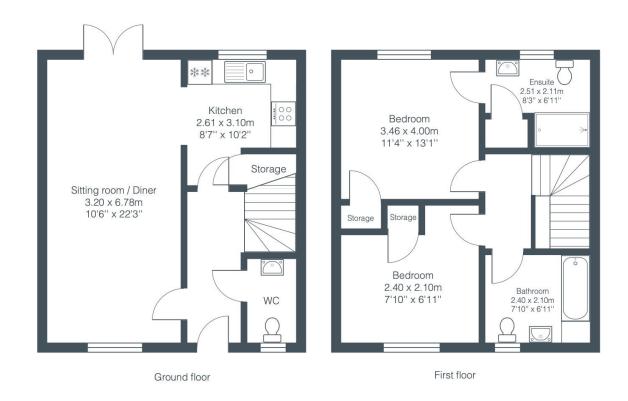
