About the property

A two-bedroom mid terrace cottage is centrally located, just a short walk to the town centre with all its shops and amenities. The cottage is one of five built in a curved terrace, all of which are unique and very characterful. Offering such unusual accommodation, it will appeal to the discerning buyer looking for something individual.

On the ground is an entrance hall housing the gas fired boiler. The sitting room lies to the front of the cottage, with stairs rising to the first floor and a dining room with patio doors on to the rear garden. Beyond this is a very pretty kitchen/breakfast room which also doubles as a garden room, with glazed windows and door overlooking the courtyard garden to the rear. The kitchen is fitted with a range of floor and wall mounted units with a free-standing cooking range and a utility cupboard.

On the first floor are two double bedrooms and a refitted family shower room with a white suite.

To the front of the property is a small, paved garden and to the rear is a larger and fully enclosed paved courtyard garden which enjoys a sunny aspect. This has a high degree of privacy and includes a garden shed and gated pedestrian access the rear parking spaces.

This property comes with designated off-road parking.

Amenities

The historic market town of Faringdon, dating back at least to the 12th century, has a thriving community and amenities such as the Leisure Centre, Library, Faringdon Community College, The Elms and Folly View primary schools as well as The Old Station Nursery, doctors' and dentists' surgeries and The Place Family Centre. Buses travel from the town to private schools at Abingdon. The town now boasts three large supermarkets.

Faringdon is also ideally positioned for the A420, leading to the A34, M40 and M4 and mainline railway services from Swindon, Oxford, Oxford Parkway and Didcot Parkway. There is a frequent bus service through the town from Swindon to Oxford and back, linking to rail services and airports.

The Tower on Folly Hill was built by Lord Berners in 1935 and affords panoramic views across four counties. For over 20 years, the town has been twinned with Le Mêle-sur-Sarthe in France and more recently with Königstein im Taunus in Germany. In 2004, Faringdon became the first Fairtrade town in the South East of England.

From Faringdon Market Place (by car), proceed through Cornmarket and up Marlborough Street. At the roundabout, turn left into Station Road and left again into Bromsgrove before The Swan public house. Blissett Terrace is on the next corner, where the road bends to the left and the property is the first one.

On foot, proceed through Cornmarket and up Marlborough Street. Turn left into Bromsgrove (no entry signs) and the property can be found on the right hand side, by the next corner.

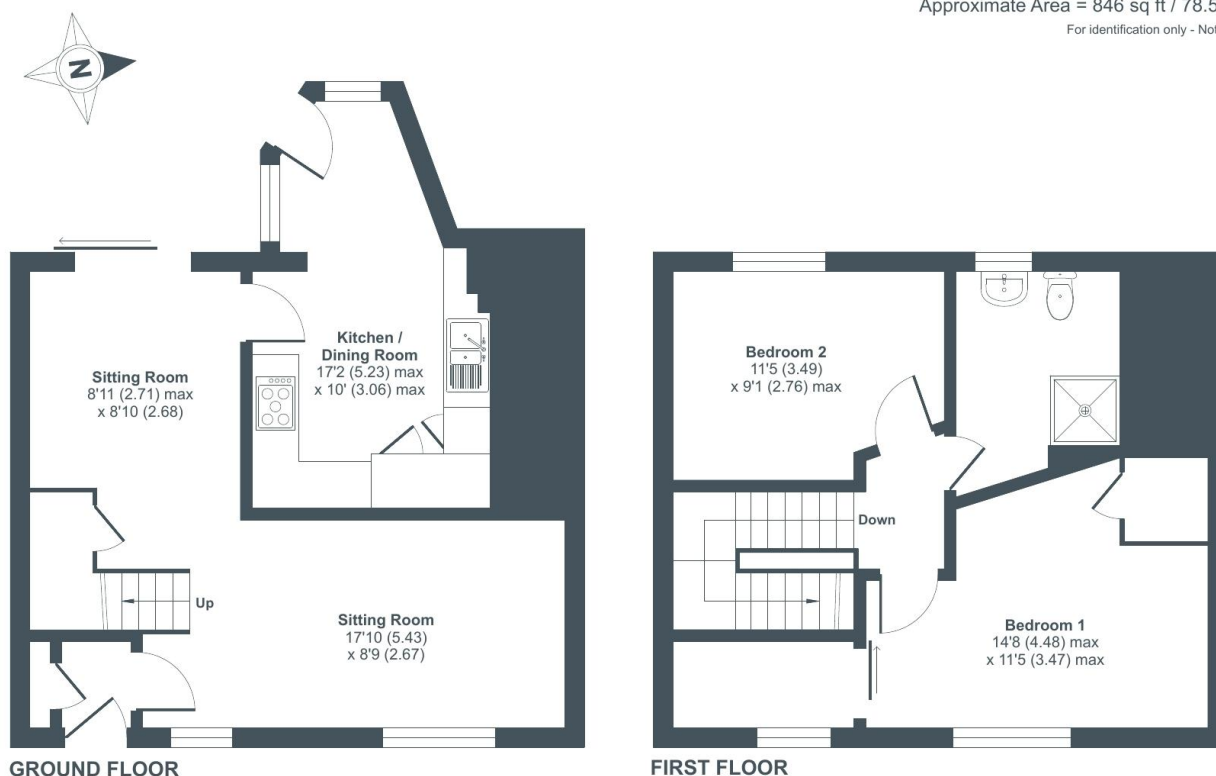
The house is cosy yet spatially good considering its only 2 bedrooms and because of the private carpark, feels safe and secure
