This former Methodist chapel built around the mid to late 19th Century having been extended in more recent years is of a traditional construction with an approximate floor area of 84m2 standing within a rectangular site gravelled to the east side and concrete paved to the north end which fronts the village road.

The property can be summarised as follows:

Chapel (10m x 5m) with porch to north end.

Lobby, disabled adapted unisex cloakroom and kitchen (3m x 4m overall).

## Outside

To the south end is a small, raised garden.

From the White Hart roundabout on the A419 take the exit towards Shrivenham and Watchfield. Head along the A420 for approx. 7 miles take the right exit at the second roundabout signposted Longcot. Take the next left onto Shrivenham Road, Longcot Village is the next tuning on your left, as you enter the centre of the village past St Mary Church take a right on to Fernham Road and Longcot Church is directly on your right.
